


NOTICE OF MEETING

 - c. deeds and easements; and
 - d. update on City of Pearland's expansion of sewage treatment plant.
8. Recreational facilities in and near the District, including termination of Cost Sharing Agreement for Maintenance of Temporary Ball Fields.
9. Security Services Report and approval of security patrol services agreement.
10. Newsletter and website, including approve articles and postings and select photos from resident submissions.
11. Attorney's report, including discussion regarding Blue Ridge Landfill odor matter.
12. Storm Water Permit TXRQ40000.
13. Reports from Directors and District consultants regarding events and activities attended during the month.
