


## NOTICE OF MEETING

### BRAZORIA COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 26

The Board of Directors of Brazoria County Municipal Utility District No. 26 will hold a regular meeting on Tuesday, September 6, 2016, at 11:00 a.m., at the office of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2600, in the Colorado Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following:

1. Minutes of prior meeting(s).
2. Comments from the public.
3. Development in the District and approval of any financing agreements and execution of waivers of special appraisal.
4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including:
  - a. payment of the bills and investment of District funds;
  - b. adopt budget for fiscal year end September 30, 2017;
  - c. authorize auditor to conduct audit for fiscal year end September 30, 2016;
  - d. conduct annual review of Investment Policy and adopt Resolution Regarding Annual Review of Investment Policy; and
  - e. review, revise and adopt Resolution Establishing the Authorized Depository Institutions and Adopting List of Qualified Broker/Dealers with Whom the District May Engage in Investment Transactions.
5. Tax assessment and collection matters, including:
  - a. delinquent tax collections, installation agreements, and payment of tax bills;
  - b. approve Payment Services Agreement; and
  - c. conduct public hearing regarding District's tax rate, adopt Order Levying Taxes, and authorize execution of Amendment to Information Form.
6. Engineering matters, including:
  - a. design of District facilities, approval of plans and specifications, authorization to advertise for bids, award of construction contracts, and execution of any related letter financing agreements;
  - b. construction of District facilities, including approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance, as appropriate;
  - c. deeds and easements;
  - d. update on City of Pearland's expansion of sewage treatment plant; and
  - e. City of Pearland's schedule for construction of regional sports park.
7. Recreational facilities in and near the District, including maintenance of temporary ball fields.

8. Security Services Report and approval of security patrol services agreement.
9. Newsletter and website, including approve articles and postings and select photos from resident submissions.
10. Attorney's report, including update District Information Kit.
11. Storm Water Permit TXRQ40000.
12. Reports from Directors and District consultants regarding events and activities attended during the month and discuss assisting SCRMA with payment for certain items eligible for MUD expenditures.
